1886: 400,000 workers throughout the nation went on strike for the 8 hour day... in Chicago 2 days later, police fired into a crowd of strikers, killing 4 people. A protest meeting was called for Haymarket Square. As police advanced to break up the meeting, a bomb exploded killing 7 policemen. 8 anarchist leaders were unjustly put on trial though there was no evidence linking them to the bombing. They were convicted and 4 were hanged. One of the hanged men, August Spies: "If you think that by hanging us you can stamp out the labor movement—the movement from which the downtrodden millions who toil and live in want and misery, the wage slaves, expect salvation—if this is your opinion, hang us! Here you will tread upon a spark, but there and here...everywhere, flames will blaze up. It is a subterranean fire. You cannot put it out."
